I. ORGANIZATION OF WORK

- l. Scheduling tasks for the school year.
- 2. Determine the rules of cooperation in the school environment.
 - * Getting to know the pedagogue's working hours (notice boards).
- 3. Cooperate with other institutions

Presentation of forms of cooperation with tutors and parents.

Determine the rules of cooperation.

Collaborate with junior high schools to keep track of last year's graduates.

Cooperation with local government structures.

- 4. Conducting pedagogical documentation.
 - * Establish and keep a daily diary of school teachers.
 - * Preparation of application forms and notices.
 - * Collect and organize opinions according to class membership.
 - * Make lists of students directed to various forms of help.

II. EDUCATION

1.Study work of school authorities related to the realization of its basic functions.

Work in teacher teams and committees.

- * Collaboration with school organizations
- 2. To recognize students' educational problems and their situation in terms of knowledge needs, lack of school news, micro-degradation and developmental disorders.
 - * Conducting a survey.

Conducting interviews with tutors and parents.

- * Observing student behavior during lessons, breaks and school events.
- * Drawing up a list of students with educational and didactic difficulties.
- 3. Analizing and searching for the causes of educational and didactic problems in the aforementioned needs of students.
 - * Conversations and individual activities with students.
 - * Conversations with parents.
 - * Directing students to PPP or other specialist clinics.
 - * Consultation with PPP employees.
 - * Working in teaching teams.
 - * Analysis of professional literature.
- 4. Providing psychological and pedagogical assistance to students with educational difficulties.
 - * Directing students to corrective-compensatory, didactic and compensatory classes, and preparing the documentation for the matriculation exam.
 - * Organizing peer self-help groups, mediation.

III. HEALTH PROTECTION AND PROMOTION

- 1. Enjoying a healthy lifestyle.
 - * Promote health in collaboration with physical education teachers.
 - * Cooperation with teachers implementing preventive programs.
 - * Development of a set of scenarios for classroom hours.
- 2. Prevention of pathologies and addictions.
 - * Comprehensive recognition of the situation of morally distracted, socially maladjusted pupils, alcoholic, criminogenic, poorly educated children.
 - * Compiling and updating lists of the above. Students in collaboration with:
 - -Policies, curators,
 - * Provide first-aid psychological help and referral to specialist providers for students and families.
 - * Organizing material support (school fellowships help in completing applications, checking, assistance in the implementation of the scholarship controlling purchases, settlement)
- 3. Counteracting aggression. Minimizing aggressive behavior.
 - * Interventions. Conversations with the aggressor, victim and witnesses. Mediation.

IV. CARE

- 1. Caring for the safety of the student at school and beyond school.
 - * Conversations and talks with students and parents.

Cooperation with the Police and the City Police.

- 2. Cooperation with institutions and persons providing social assistance.
 - * Exchange of information and cooperation in the scope of providing financial support from OPS, Caritas, PCK, sociotherapeutic centers.
- 3. Helping disadvantaged students including large families, those affected by unemployment, single parents, pathological families, and those who have been harmed by fate.
 - * Commenting on the application of social and school scholarships and school allowance (assistance in completing and implementing)
 - * Applications for dinner sponsorship.
- 4. Provide support to teachers.
 - * Conversations with teachers about the causes of student learning difficulties and behavior, and how to help these students.
 - * Providing and analyzing opinions and judgments.

Supporting teachers in the work of teaching teams.

- * Development of a set of scenarios for prevention and education.
- * Helping educators to prepare scenario scenarios.
- 5. Providing advice and cooperation with parents.
 - * Preparing materials for meetings with parents.
 - * Conversations with parents of students with learning disabilities and social adjustment.
 - * Forwarding and analyzing opinions issued by PPP or others.
