

I'm from Poland. I live in Giżycko. I'm twelve years old. I haven't got any brothers or sisters. I have dark blond hair and blue eyes.





My town Giżycko is located in the northeast Poland between two big lakes, Niegocin and Kisajno.




About thirty thousand people live here. There are a lot of trees. In the crest of Giżycko we can see three breams on the blue backround.


