- In 70- ties became Saturday part of the weekend




Lessons

- ▶ In primary school were lessons in different times
- ▶ In first week were school lessons in the morning, but in second week were lesson in the afternoon
- ▶ In one day were 4 lessons, because in one class were 28–30 pupils



Breaks

- ▶ Breaks took 5–10 minutes
 - ▶ Pupils had to be in School hall only on 15 minute break
 - ▶ They had lunch in school too for a small charge
- 

School uniforms

- ▶ On primary school they didn't wear uniforms, but on National holiday they wore Pioneer uniforms (light-blue blouse, dark-blue skirt or panties and red scarf to neck)
- ▶ In high school they could wear school uniforms if they wanted,
- ▶ they usually sewed it by themselves



Activities

- ▶ They had many activities in school, like carnival, School in Nature (trip for three weeks)
- ▶ It were poor times, so mothers sewed costumes for children (my granny was Netherlands girl, her sister was Daisy flower,..)
