School system in year 1996 and in year 2016. In this school project I compare school systems in years 1996 and 2016.

20 years ago:

Children were called pioneers. All pupils belonged to pioneer units. On special occasions they wore uniforms. It was white shirt and red scarf, trousers or skirt. Children also wore pioneer badges. Pioneers were members of various hobby groups. They popular were sports and nature groups.

Russian language was the only foreign language at schools. It was compulsory for all children ages 10-14.



There were not any computer lessons since computers were not discovered yet.

Jeans and make up were not allowed.

20 years ago and TODAY:

We start school at 8:00 AM and finish at 13:00 P.M. We have 6 or 7 lessons every day. School lesson takes 45 minutes and breaks take 10 or 15 minutes. Lunch is served in a school canteen.



TODAY:

Pioneer units do not exist since 1989. Children still like various sports and they are members of sports clubs. Football, floorball are very popular.

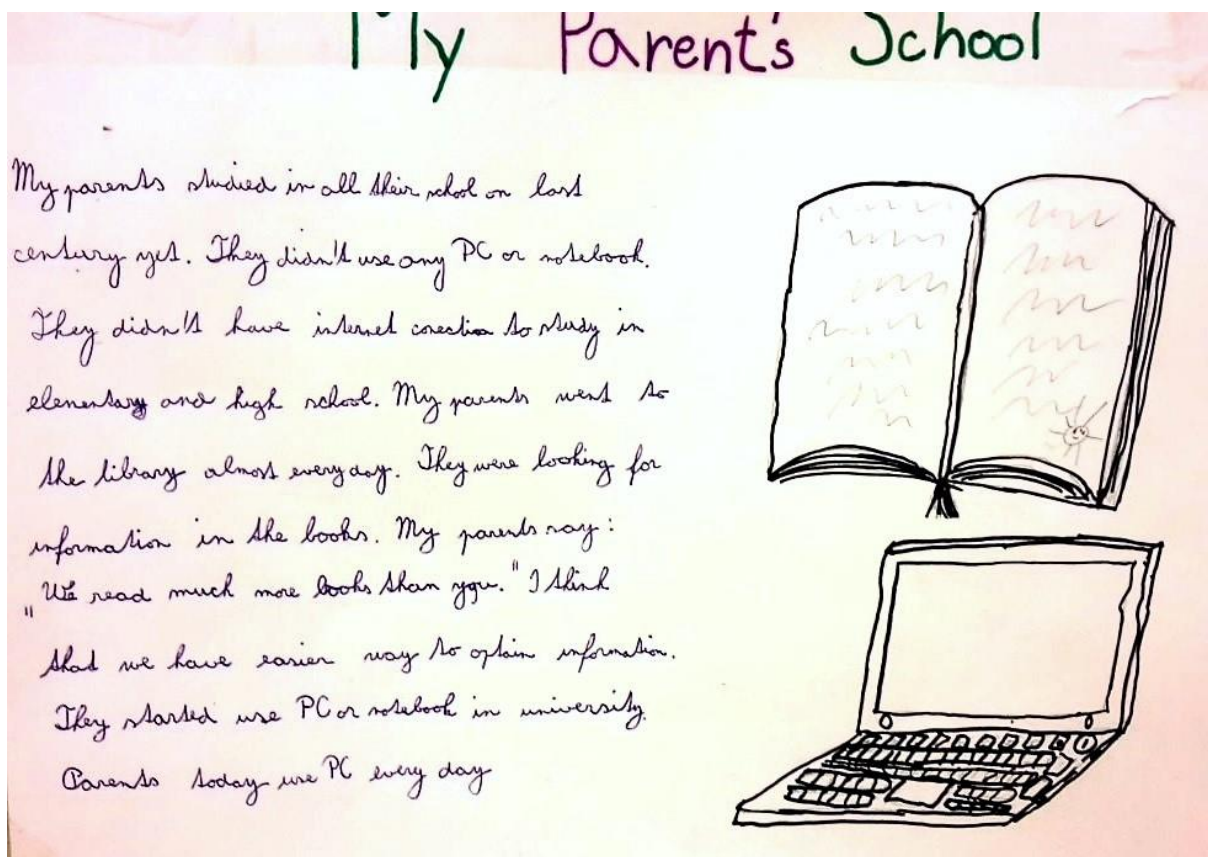
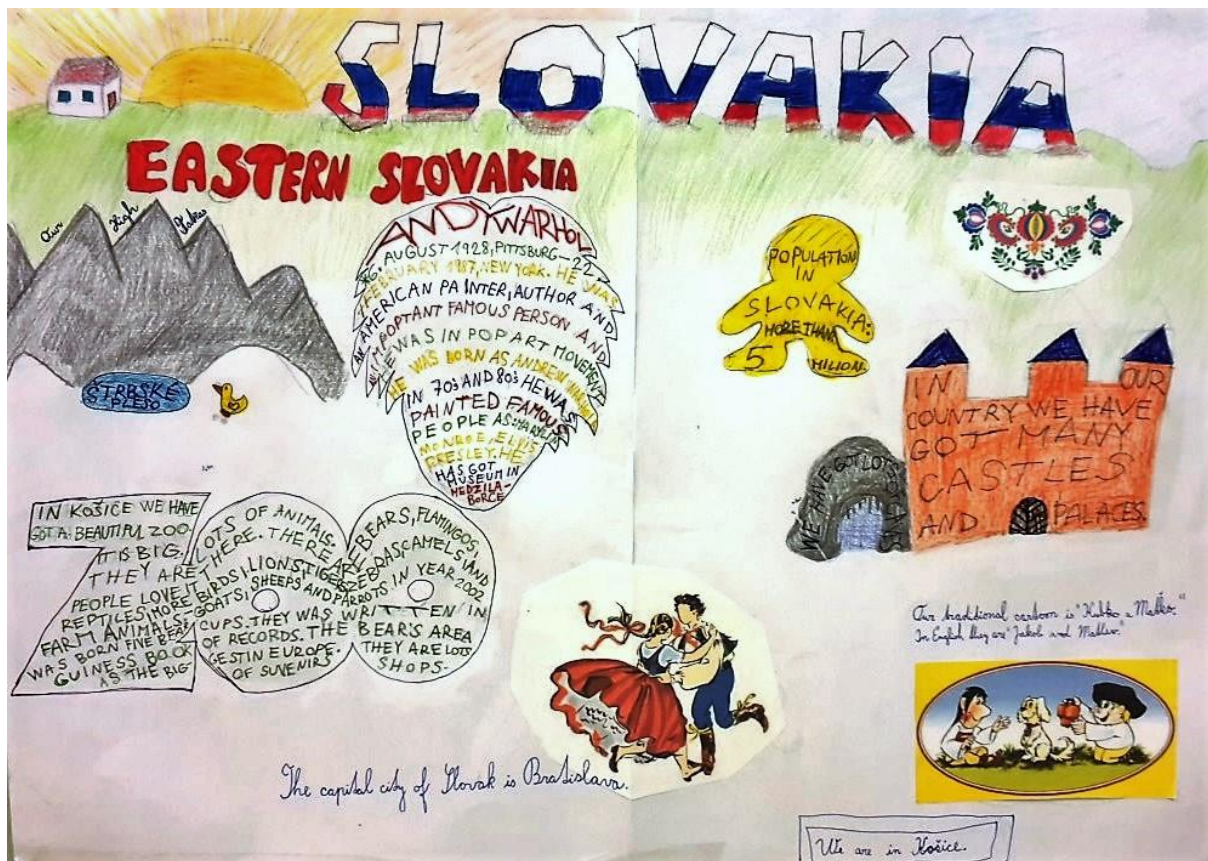


English language is compulsory for all children since the 1. (1st) grade. Second foreign language can be german or russian. It is compulsory since the 5. grade.

We have computer lessons once a week.

School SYSTEM IN SOCIALISM



My parents learnt Russian at school. Sometimes they went to school on Saturday.

They didn't love autumn holiday. When they had PE, girls were wearing blue shorts and white t-shirts. Boys had red shorts and white t-shirts.

They had no salaried teachers "čest' praci".

and they called teachers like "učitel'na miterka" and "učitel' miterka". My mum went to school by bus. My dad collected LC.

YEAR 1987

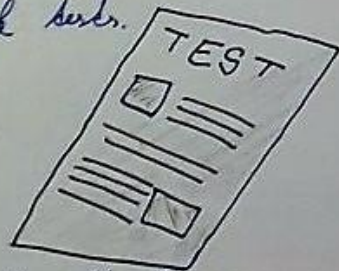
My mom usually walked to school with friends. My mom used ink pen.



My mom collected cacha and post stamps. My mom had a cook, sewing and building lesson. My mom had lunch at school then me too. My mom said that she had test almost every lesson. My mom had sports like badminton, table tennis and pioneer. It was children organization which they was supported with state.

NOW

I went to the school by a car. We usually don't go to school with friends. We usually have a gel pens which we can erase. We collect Pokemon cards. We have robotic and computer lessons. We have lunch in the school. We don't have lot of tests.



But we don't have sports like badminton, table tennis and pioneer. And our children organization is scout where children collect badges for our work.



Mom's school life

My mom was born in 1971. She started school as a 7 year old child. She really liked to study. They didn't have English back then. It upsets her, because she doesn't understand everything. They could only choose from Russian or German. My mom chose Russian. They didn't even have modern technologies like: computers, mobile phones or printers. People back then read more books and magazines and they used libraries for researching. The classrooms were old and didn't have modern furniture. The students were often punished physically. My mom said that the socialism regime had advantages and disadvantages. Advantages were that people were more socialised and disadvantages were that people weren't able to search information fast. My ending is that I wouldn't like to live at that time.



My school life

I don't like going to school like anyone else. Studying nowadays is completely different than the one back then. We have modern classes with modern equipment. We have to learn English and choose from one of these languages: Spanish, German, Russian or French. Students are assigned assignments which are usually completed with the help of an electronic device such as: essays, presentations etc. Students have many opportunities regarding selection of school and studying programme. People usually start in the kindergarten then they go to a primary school after that they go to middle school and finally they graduate in a high school, they can choose whether they'll go to a university or not. Some schools allow the usage of mobile phones. Some people in high schools study in foreign countries to improve their language skills. Some students have after school clubs such as: piano, guitar, art, drama, soccer, tennis...





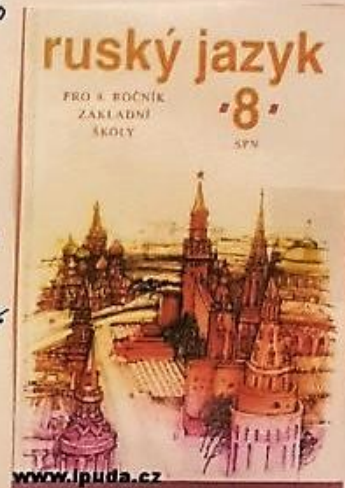
Schools in socialism

When my parents were students on middle school it was different then now. In class was picture of president CSSR. Most popular was Gustáv Husák. There was a table of socialism holiday. They didn't learn religious education. They studied only one foreign language. When students have in work week free day, they must learnt in school on Saturday. They didn't have Autumn holiday, only Spring, Summer and Christmas holiday. Schools kept relationship



with another schools in ZSSR, NDR. This called "Družba". Students must wrote letters between each other. Students were arranged to Inkričky and Pionierky. Inkričky were from 1. class to 4. class and

Pionierky from 5. class to 9. class. Pionier is something like Scout. They studied about Vladimir Iljič Lenin. In school prepared Spartakiáda. Spartakiáda was mass work out in town. On 1. May all students were on parade for working people.



SCHOOL IN THE PAST



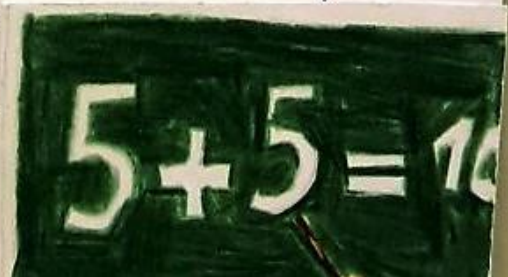
Elementary school:

My grandma started school in 1954 in Michalovec. The first stage was from 1 to 5 years and the second stage was from 6 to 9 years. They had a working teaching. Boys went to the workshop and learnt to produce different things. Girls learnt to embroider, to knit and to cook. In elementary school were folk groups where they can choose between dance and singing groups. Compulsory foreign language was Russian. They had a recitation competition "Buskein monument". On maths had mathematical olympic. They didn't have any uniform. On the physical education they trained Spasaliada too. They had pioneer's camps and they were free. My grandma was isbricka and pionier.

High school:

My grandma went to high industry school in Košice. My grandma started high school in 1963. Compulsory foreign languages were Slovak and Russian. Voluntary languages were English, German and Spanish. Grandma had 41 students - 39 boys and 2 girls ^{in the class}. My grandma went on tourist ring. My grandma was in 3rd year at the winter camp. They went on excursions, for example in Dobruša a hydroelectric power, in Eastern Germany on engineering exhibition. Textbook and all items were free.

My grandma didn't have calculators, but on the maths used a slide rule. Industry high school lasted 4 years and finished graduation in 1967.



School in past

PRIMARY SCHOOL:

My mom went to primary school so Tomášivová. She went to primary school from 1977 to 1984. They had only 8-year schooling. They had pioneer meetings. In Tomášivová school was playing basketball. In the second level was basketball grade. And there went my mom. Other interest rings were: photography, volleyball. They had paper collection. And besides that they had: orange peels collection and chestnuts collection. During school they had technical education. They learnt: cooking, sew, grow vegetables. And they had work shop. On physical education they rehearsed spartakiáda. On physical education they wore uniform. Boys wore ~~blue~~^{red} shorts and white T-shirts. Girls wore blue shorts and white T-shirts. They went to ski trip in the winter, but it took 1 week.



HIGHT SCHOOL:

Then mom went to high school.

She went to high school from 1984 to 1989. This high school situate in Hořice on street Dobrušivová. The whole class went to potato brigades. And in summer they go to brigade cannery.

UNIVERSITY:

Then mom went to university. She went to university from 1989 to 1993. This was economic university in Banská Bystrica. She lived in college. When mom finished study, this economic university was renamed: University of Matej Bela.



SCHOOL IN THE Post

Primary school

My mother went on primary school Zmarikova. She went to school from 1977 to 1984. They had only 8-year schooling. They had nothing teaching. They learnt to cook, to sew, to work with hammer, to grow vegetables and make a little things.

On physical education wore uniforms. Boys had white T-shirts and blue shorts. Girls had white T-shirts and blue shorts. On physical education in one year rehearsed Spartakiada. On 2. stage was basketball class, where went my mother.

Expend (Except for play) they visited volleyball and photographs rings. They had ^{to collect} (collection) paper, orange peels and chestnuts. They had winter camp, school in nature and in summer went (on) to pioniers camps.

HIGHT SCHOOL

My mother went ^{night} (day) school from 1984 to 1989 to (Banha Bystrie) All days went on potato brigade. In ^{house} and went in summer on brigade in innamery to Nitra.

UNIVERSITY:

My mother spent on UNIVERSITY in Banha Bystrie. She lived on ^{the} college. She (studied) studied from 1989 to 1993.

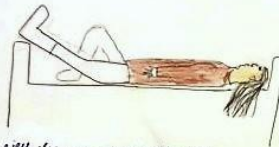


Mum's School

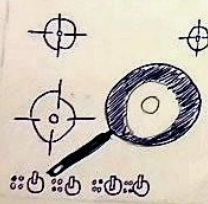
My mum lived in city Krasnodar.

 Boys learned to work with a hammer and nails.

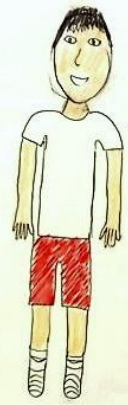


They had school on Saturday, too.
